

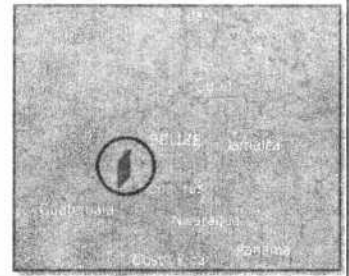

9. Consult the Tour Operator's Dive Policy.
10. No announcement will be made for any tour departures. It is the guest's responsibility to meet 15 minutes prior to departure.
11. Guests with walking difficulties / wheelchairs are to please consult the shore excursion personnel prior to booking your tours.

SHORE EXCURSION CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

All cancellations are subject to a 25% cancellation fee. Tours cancelled within 24 hours of port arrival are non refundable. Guests who leave during a tour which includes transportation must return to the ship at their own cost. Some tours require a minimum number of guests to operate, if this minimum is not met, the tour may be cancelled.

TOUR MEETING PLACE / TOUR DEPARTURE TIME:

Please review your tour tickets for your meeting points and departure times. Ensure to meet at the designated meeting point 15 minutes prior to the departure time.

You'll get a glimpse of the business, historic and cultural aspects of Belizean life. Beautiful landmarks and old colonial buildings mixed with modern architecture give the "Old Belize Capital" a Caribbean charm. Leaving the city, you'll travel onto the Northern Highway, for approximately 45 minutes, passing several quaint villages en route to the Altun Ha Mayan ruins. Two plazas and thirteen structures are at the epicenter of this Mayan ceremonial site. Prepared stone steps allow visitors to climb atop three of the main temples. Note: Minimum age is 3 years. This excursion involves walking on inclines and over uneven terrain; it is not wheelchair accessible. A small selection of souvenirs and crafts are available for purchase. Restrooms are available at the site. Light cool clothing, comfortable walking shoes, sunscreen, a hat and insect repellent are recommended. \$86.95 Adult \$70.95 Child	ALTUN HA MAYAN SITE & RIVER WALLACE Tour Duration: 6 Hours    A double treat awaits you in the Belize district. Hold on to your hat as you enjoy an exhilarating boat ride along the city's scenic coast before entering the Belize River, called Rio Wallace. After approximately 1½ hours on the river, you will have a 30 to 45-minute stop at a riverside dock where you can use the restroom, browse the gift shop or purchase a local lunch before boarding a coach for the second part of your adventure. Altun Ha is the Mayan ceremonial center where the famous jade head of the Sun God Kinich Ahau was found during an expedition led by Professor David Pendergast of the Royal Ontario Museum. The site, which is set in pristine rainforest, has three plazas and thirteen structures within its epicenter and was a vital trade center during the Classic Period (250-900 AD). Stone steps allow you to climb the main temples (weather permitting). Note: Minimum age is 4 years. Lunch is available for purchase at the Black Orchid Resort riverside rest stop. Since the boats are partially uncovered, a hat, sunscreen, and insect repellent are recommended. This excursion involves walking on inclines and over uneven terrain; it is not allowed during or after rain due to safety reasons. Tour may operate in reverse. The largest temple, El Castillo, has been excavated and partially restored; Delve into the Mayan world as you visit the site's three plazas and partially excavated ball court. After exploring this ancient Mayan site, you will return to the San Ignacio area for a local lunch. Note: Minimum age is 3 years. Travel time from the pier to Xunantunich is approximately two hours. Follow your guide into the forest and listen as Black Howler Monkeys and parrots nesting in the palm fronds call out across the forest.
