Self Project 20%

Students will be graded on an extensive self project that will have various checkpoints. This project will include a research paper and a presentation portion.

College Project 20%

Students will be graded on an extensive research project on three universities of their choice. This project will include many mini essays and compare/contrast activities.

ACT/SAT

Students will be graded on their participation of the online ACT/SAT prep assignments. Students are expected to spend 30 minutes a week on the online ACT/SAT prep. Students will be given the subject to complete for that given week.

Daily Round Up 10%

Students will be graded on short writing prompts given daily for their daily response and check in.

One on One 20%

Students will be graded on our weekly conversation about their academic life.

Aid the Diva 15%

Students will be graded on AVID specific curriculum activities to include their Cornell Notes and SLC.
