Notice to opt out of pension saving

You might be thinking of opting out of the FPS 1992/FPS 2006/FPS 2015 for a variety of reasons. Whatever the reason, it's worth taking some time to look at the benefits you could be giving up.

Opting out might not save you as much in take home pay as you may think. In most cases, you will pay more tax if you opt out of the Firefighter Pension Schemes. A basic rate tax payer paying pension contributions of £100 a month will pay £20 more tax.

You may wish to consider these 10 good reasons for remaining a member of the Firefighters Pension Schemes:

- 1 Tax relief on the contributions you pay
- 2 Your employer contributes too
- **3** Safe and guaranteed pension with no investment risk
- 4 Life cover no medicals required
- 5 Protection for your loved ones if you die
- 6 Protection if you have to leave early through ill health
- 7 No hidden fees or administration charges
- 8 Option of a tax free lump sum as well as a yearly pension
- 9 Your pension rises with the cost of living
- **10** Enjoy a better quality of retirement

Whatever your reasons for considering opting out of the scheme, we ask that you give this matter careful consideration before making a final decision. You may wish to take independent financial advice before making a decision to opt out. If you are opting out of the Firefighters Pension Schemes due to advice you have received you should ask for this advice in writing.

What you need to know about opting out of the Firefighter Pension Schemes

Your employer cannot ask you or force you to opt out.

If you are asked or forced to opt out, you can tell The Pensions Regulator - see www.tpr.gov.uk

If you change your mind you may be able to opt back in – write to your employer if you want to do this.

If you stay opted out, your employer will normally put you back into pension saving in around three years.

If you change your job, your new employer will normally put you back into pension saving straight away.

If you have another job, your other employer might also put you into pension saving, now or in the future. This notice only allows you to opt out of pension saving with the employer (and job) you name above. A separate notice must be filled out and given to any other employer you work for, if you wish to opt out of that employer's pension saving as well.

If you move to the FPS 2015 from the FPS 1992 or FPS 2006 and then opt out, this will affect your pension in all the firefighters pension schemes.

I have read the attached documentation and understand that the choices I make now are important in planning for my retirement. I confirm that I wish to opt out of the pension scheme in relation to the post I have indicated on this form.
