

33rd Annual Senior High Exhibition Guidelines

For public and private school teachers and homeschool educators teaching 9-12th grade in Benton, Washington, Madison, and Carroll counties.

Dates: Entry deadline: Friday, February 19, 2016
Drop off: Feb. 22 - 26, 2016
Show dates: March 3 - April 1, 2016
Reception: Saturday, March 12, 2016, 1 - 3PM
Pick up: April 4 - 8, 2016

Awards and prizes will be announced March 11th on our website www.acozarks.org

*No work may be picked up before April 1st.*All work should be picked up by the teacher or appointed representative no later than April 8th
When picking up work make sure you check all works going out with the lists form that you handed in at checkin. ACO is not responsible for works that are left behind or taken by another teacher. So please make sure you have all of your students work before leaving the building.

Restrictions: Each student may submit up to two entries. Each school may submit up to 10 entries per grade.

Presentation: *2 Dimensional works must be matted and properly prepared for hanging.
The plastic hangtab found at Hobby Lobby is the preferred hangtab for matted works. (see sample)
The saw tooth part of the hangtab should protrude slightly from the top of the work for easy hanging.



*3 Dimensional works should be free standing or ready to hang.
*Teachers must make labels to be displayed on the FRONT of the work.
*Labels must be made using a self adhesive label.
*Labels must be visible and securely attached to the work.
*3 Dimensional work must be physically labeled and must also have a table top label to display with the work.

Labeling:

*Labels must include the following information:
Student's name(s)
Teacher's Name
School name
Grade Level (indicate if "AP")
Title of Work (if work does not have a title use "untitled")
Media / Category

WORK NOT PROPERLY LABELED OR PREPARED FOR HANGING WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE SHOW.

List of Works: Include a List of Works Form with each school's entries. Please Print Legibly.

Liability: Every care will be taken in handling the artwork; however, the Arts Center of the Ozarks cannot be responsible for loss or damage.

Categories: Drawing I(graphite, charcoal)DrawingII(colored pencil, pastel)DrawingIII(pen & ink, marker)
Painting Transparent(watercolor), Opaque(oil, acrylic, tempera, gouache)
Clayworks(ceramics, pottery) 3-D Work(fibers, sculpture, etc)
Mixed media, Miscellaneous(fiber, batik, scratchboard) & Printmaking

*Work that does not fit neatly into one of the above categories will be placed at the discretion of the Director.

*Any Category that does not have 5 or more works will be put into the Misc. Category.
