Request:

We would like to request the following information. Please can you tell us:

- 1. What speed was the fastest driver caught speeding in your area so far in 2014, 2013 and 2012 and what road (and postcode) was this person caught speeding on?
- 2. How many speed cameras are there in your force area?
- 3. How many speed cameras have your force removed/decommissioned for each year over the past five years (2010 to 2014-to-date)? Please provide a figure for each year.
- 4. How many new speed cameras has your force installed for each year over the past five years (2010 to 2014-to-date)? Please provide a figure for each year.
- 5. How many mobile camera patrols were in operation in an average month in 2014, 2013 and 2012? (Please provide a figure for each year)
- 6. How many drivers have been/were caught speeding in your force area over the past three years? (Please provide a figure for 2014-to-date, 2013 and 2012).
- 7. How many drivers have were given court summons for speeding in your force area over the past three years? (Please provide a figure for 2014, 2013 and 2012).
- 8. How many drivers have were given FPNs for speeding in your force area over the past three years? (Please provide a figure for 2014, 2013 and 2012).

<u>Clarification</u>: The applicant was contacted and advised of the following: *"With reference to Question 6 (drivers caught speeding), the following link will take you to a response published on our Disclosure Log in relation to a similar request (336/2013). Response 4:

The applicant has not responded to this request for clarification and therefore this question will remain unanswered.

Response 5:

I can confirm that Dyfed Powys Police does hold the information requested. Dyfed Powys Police had 8 mobile cameras in 2012, 2013 and 2014 (to date) – therefore, an average month would have had 8 mobile cameras being used.
