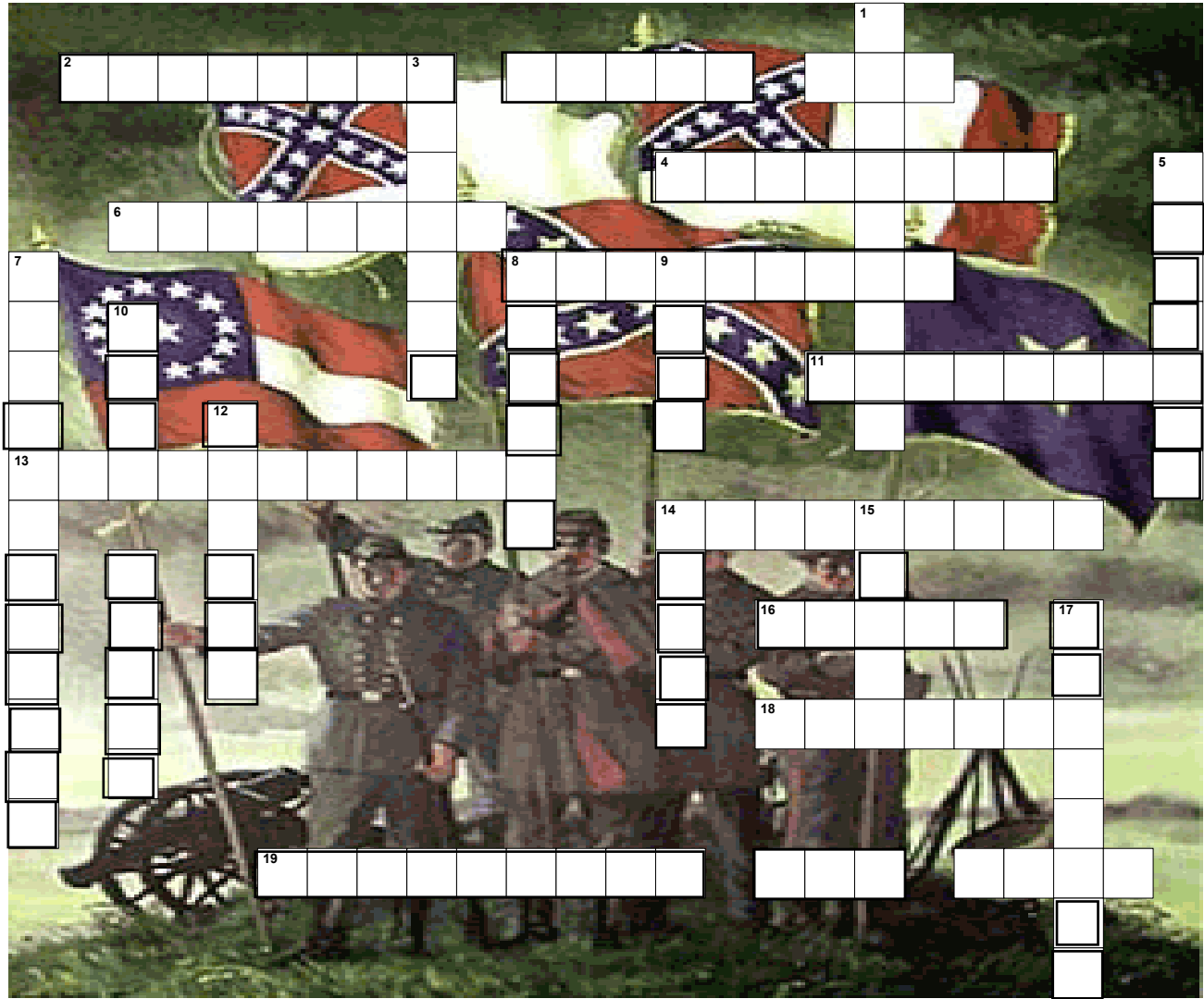

- 2) Act requiring return of fugitive slaves to their masters
- 4) Site of convention in present-day WV where representatives voted to repeal Virginia's Ordinance of Secession
- 6) Confederate iron-clad which fought the Union's Monitor
- 8) What Union troops did at the 1st Battle of Manassas (i.e., ran away)
- 11) Battlefield near Washington where Confederates first defeated unprepared Union troops
- 13) States of America in rebellion from the Union
- 14) Act of withdrawing from an organization, union, or political entity

- 16) President of the Confederate States of America
- 18) Elected President in 1860 because the Democrats were split North & South over slavery
- 19) First RR in America which Virginia helped fund as it went west with connections South into the Valley at Harper's Ferry

- 1) General who rebuilt/retrained the Union Army after its defeat at 1st Manassas
- 3) Union effort to keep goods from leaving Southern ports for sale in Europe (e.g., cotton to England)
- 5) Famous Southern general who fought 3 Union armies at one time for control of Virginia's Shenandoah Valley
- 7) Lincoln's Proclamation that freed slaves in States that were in rebellion from the Union
- 8) Southern coastal fort where Confederates 1st fired upon the Union forces
- 9) Former slave who was found to be property without citizenship rights by the US Supreme Court
- 10) Abolitionist leader to led an attack on the armory at Harper's Ferry
- 12) Lincoln's Secretary of State who was also famous for buying Alaska from the Russians
- 15) Number of days that Union and Confederate forces fought outside Richmond in 1862
- 17) A major RR station where 2 or more RRs came together with rare interconnectivity
