

- 2) Principal farming crop in Virginia during Reconstruction
- 4) Crop that was "King" in the deep South
- 8) Action against Andrew Johnson for his firing of "tenured" cabinet members
- 11) Reconstruction Judge who dominated 1867-68 Constitutional Convention in Virginia
- 12) Southern State legislation intended to deny blacks the right to purchase or rent land

- Northerners who had migrated to the South after the Civil War in order to profit from reconstruction
- 17) Offense enforced to keep former slaves working on Southern plantations
- 19) Major East to SW RR from Lynchburg, VA into TN
- 20) Sherman's Order No. 15 gave this to former slaves
- 21) Activity where the Freedmen's Bureau was most successful

## **Down**

- 1) Leader of Re-adjuster Party who controlled 3 railroads in VA
- A new system of economic exploitation intended to trap former slaves and small white farmers into continued "servitude"
- 5) War of 1898 whereby 15 Virginians were lost and America annexed Puerto Rico and Guam
- 6) Essential transportation link for shipping production of South-Central VA to Richmond during the War
- 7) Laws that were intended to "roll back" civil/legal rights given to negros thru reconstruction in the South
- 9) Commissioner of Freedmen's Bureau for whom the traditionally black University in Wash., DC is named for
- 10) RR activity that was key to Virginia's post-war growth and development
- 13) A commodity exploited from Virginia with rebuilding of RRs in the State
- Bureau which supervised all relief and educational activities for former slaves and other refugees of the Civil War
- President elected by 1 Electorial vote including 19 disputed Southern votes in the Compromise of 1877 that ended Reconstruction
- Type of University established to increase the numbers of negros in the profession
