What is a Congregation Health Ministry Program?

A congregational health ministry/program • combines skills of health professionals, clergy/ spiritual leaders, and other congregation members to promote wholeperson health. •

A health ministry/program can include such offerings as prayer groups, visiting the sick, nutrition classes, health screenings and evaluations, or financial health seminars, to name just a few ideas. Such programs help people to achieve their full potential for healthy independent living and well-being.

Health Ministry/Programs are led by Congregational Health Leaders who have completed a basic training that helps them identify their gifts and develop skills in promoting wholeness of body, mind and spirit as the essence of health.

Training Program Description

The training will cover such topics as "Faith-Health Connection," "Building Blocks: Getting Started," and "Support for a Health Program/ Ministry." The program will conclude with a commissioning of participants to health ministry/service.

Because the sessions build upon one another, it is important that participants attend all sessions. A certificate of completion will be awarded. No certificate will be issued for less than 100% participation.

Teaching staff includes Faith Community Nurses, Registered Nurses, and clergy with extensive training and experience in Congregation Health or Nursing Ministry.

- Individuals interested in starting or enriching their congregation's existing health and wellness program.
- Members of health ministries/programs or caring/visitation committees.
- Spiritual leaders/clergypersons.
- Congregation members in health-related fields, active or retired.
