#### THE WORD BECAME FLESH

News media outlets offer plenty of lists for the "Best" and the "Most Powerful" people on the planet. For instance, *Forbes* magazine presents their annual lists for the top 100 celebrities, or for the 400 Richest Americans, or the world's most powerful women.

Other websites list the top ten most powerful people in the world, or the 50 most powerful people in Washington, D.C. But a few years ago a website called 24/7 Wall Street has an unusual twist on this theme. They call it the "100 Least Powerful People in the World List."

The list includes corporate executives, athletes, politicians, and celebrities who share one common characteristic—they *used to be* powerful. Here are some "Winners" (or "Losers") that qualified for this year's "100 Least Powerful People in the World List":

- Tony Hayward, the former CEO of BP, in 2011 the 4th largest company in the world (based on revenues). After a massive oil spill in the Gulf of Mexico, the BP board of directors eventually fired Hayward.
- Jim Keyes, the former CEO of Blockbuster, once one of the nation's largest retailers.
- Mike Jones, the current CEO of the former #1 social network—MySpace, which once had 70 million users.
- Arnold Schwarzenegger, the once powerful actor and politician in California, who is attempting to make an acting comeback after driving his state's finances into the ground
- Hosni Mubarak, the former President of Egypt who left the country in disgrace.

Some of the individuals on this least powerful list were victims of circumstances; others made poor business decisions; and others lost their influence because of moral failure. But none of them *chose* to become powerless.

In contrast, through his birth, incarnation, earthly ministry, and death on the cross, Jesus the all-powerful and sinless Son of God *chose* to become powerless for our sakes.
