What are the Commissioners?

Briefly stated, the Commissioner Service of the Boy Scoputs of America is a core of dedicated volunteer Scouters whose primary prupose is to provide service and support to Pack, Troop, Team, Venture, Post, Ship, and other Scout Leaders. This service and support is provided to help give the unit leader extra resources to assure that he or she is able to deliver the promise of Scouting to individual youth members.

District Commissioner and the Assistant District Commissioner: Their primary responsibilities are recruiting, training, guiding and evaluating the Commissioner Staff.

Unit Commissioners: Unit Commissioners are assigned to one or more units, which they serve and counsel.

Roundtable Commissioners: Roundtable Commissioners provide unit leaders with resources and training in program skills through regularly scheduled roundtable meetings.

What are the Purposes and Goals of the Commissioner Service?

The Commissioner Service exists to help units provide the best possible Scouting program, which ultimately helps assure that individual Scouts have the best opportunity of developing good character traits, participation, citizenship, skills, and personal fitness.

Broadly stated, the goals of the Commissioner Service through the execution of a successful unit service plan are to:

- 1. Help see that the objectives of Scouting are being carried out.
- 2. Assure that each unit has strong, competent unit leadership.
- 3. Promote regular meetings of unit committees.
- 4. Encourage growth in youth membership.
- 5. Help assure that Scouts and units take an active part in District and Council activities.
- 6. Foster a positive relationship between the chartered organization and its unit leaders.

Lord Robert Baden-Powell's Last Message to Scouts

Dear Scouts,

If you have ever seen the play Peter Pan you will remember how the pirate chief was always making his dying speech because he was afraid that possibly when the time came for him to die he might not have time to get it off his chest. It is much the same with me, and so, although I am not at this moment dying, I shall be doing so one of these days and I want to send you a parting word of goodbye.

Remember, it is the last you will ever hear from me, so think it over.

I have had a most happy life and I want each one of you to have as happy a life too.

I believe that God put us in this jolly world to be happy and enjoy life. Happiness doesn't come from being rich, nor merely from being successful in <u>your career</u>, nor by self-indulgence. One <u>step</u> towards happiness is to make yourself healty and strong while you are a boy, so that you can be useful and so can enjoy life when you are a man.

Nature <u>study</u> will show you how full of beautiful and wonderful things God has made the world for you to enjoy. Be contented with what you have got and make the best of it. Look on the bright side of things instead of the gloomy one.

But the real way to get happiness is by giving out happiness to other people. Try and leave this world a little better than you found it and when your turn comes to die, you can die happy in feeling that at any rate you have not wated your time but have done your best. "Be Prepared" in this way, to live happy and to die happy – stick to your Scout promise always – even after you have ceased to be a boy – and God help you do it.

Your friend, Baden-Powell

This last message was found in his papers after he had died. February 22, 1857 to January 8, 1941

I'm not a Scout Leader for the easy hours, high pay, parents' gratitude, power or prestige.

I'm a leader because I want the world for your son and mine,

I want it to be a world he can shape and help shape; a world of love and laughter, where he can show compassion.

I want him to be able to look at the stars, a sunrise, a sunset, the work and world of man – and feel their beauty inside himself.

I want to help him to learn to finish anything he starts and do it well. I want to guide him to know his worth with a deeper understanding of himself.

I want to help shape men who have strength of character and are sensitive to the needs of others. I want them to be the best they can be.

I'm giving of myself and my time. I reap rewards far beyond what I give. I receive for my children and future generations a better world. I am a Scout Leader because I care.
