Directions to JFK

From Garden State Parkway North

Take the parkway to exit 131. Make a right off the exit onto Route 27. At the fourth light (James St) make a right and the hospital is a short distance on the left. Turn into the parking lot at the light.

From Garden State Parkway South

Same as above only the turn onto James St. will be at the third light.

From the NJ Turnpike

Take Exit 11 Garden state Parkway North and follow directions above.

From Route 1 North or South

Take parsonage road exit. Continue past the mall and underpass to second traffic light at Route 27 (landmarks are the Rite Aid on the left, Dunkin Donuts on the right). Parsonage Road becomes James St. and the hospital is a short distance on the left.

Parts of this course are strenuous. If you have any known medical condition that could be affected by strenuous activity, please consult with your physician for clearance before attending the class.

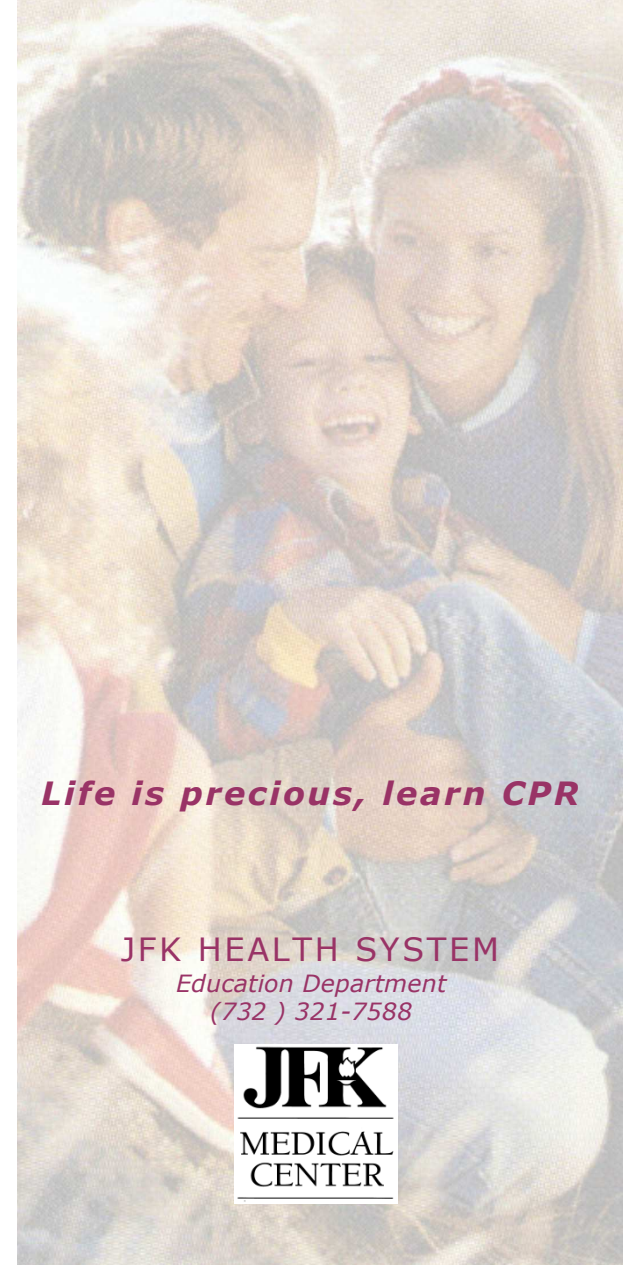
