I. QUESTION NO. 1

On page 44, there are many potential services listed as part of the scope of work, including architecture, electrical, mechanical, environmental, civil, structural, construction management, construction testing, special inspections, specialized engineering and project management, fire protection engineers, cost estimators, and schedulers.

Is traffic engineering part of the mix?

Traffic engineering may be covered by Civil Engineering for Roadway or Intelligent Transportation Systems (main categories 1 and 3 listed on Page 45 of 87).

We are soliciting consultants who are interested in providing a full suite of services for each of the four main "CATEGORIES" listed on Page 45 of 87 of the original solicitation document. We encourage that specialty firms skilled in one or a few select "List of Disciplines" and "List of Experience Categories" beginning on pages 66, 67, 68 and 69 of 87 to partner with other firms so that they may join a team that can provide all of the required skill and experience sets necessary to perform work in one or more of the four main "CATEGORIES" listed on Page 45 of 87 of the original solicitation document.

The list of SF 330 Disciplined listed on pages 11 & 12 of 87 are a partial list of profile codes provided in the instructions for the SF330 forms.

II. QUESTION NO. 2

There are a minimum of 5 slots for consultants (p4).

Will all of the above consulting services be chosen separately or should teams try to provide multiple services?

For example, we are an archaeological firm who could put together a team of environmentalists to fulfill the environmental component. Would that suffice?
