ST. MARY MAGDALEN CONSULTATIVE BODIES (COUNCILS & COMMISSIONS)

"It is the role of the Christian faithful to carry out the mission of the Church in the world, and therefore all parishioners share the responsibility for that mission with the pastor. They are called to be responsible stewards of the resources of time, talent and treasure given to them and to the parish. The pastor, by way of appointment as well as ordination, exercises a central leadership role in the parish. Using a model of servant leadership, he seeks to build a unified faith community and to be a link to the larger Church. He is responsible for parish governance and therefore provides leadership for the Pastoral Council, Finance Council, Stewardship Council, Corporal Works of Mercy Commission, School Commission, Spiritual Works of Mercy Commission and Worship Commission as well as the parish staff in accord with Diocesan and universal Church guidelines.

- The *Pastoral Council* is responsible for the visioning, planning and development of all St. Mary Magdalen ministries and programs, while the *Finance Council* is responsible for overseeing the resources of the parish (financial, human, computer and other temporal resources) to be used to carry out the vision and direction set by the Pastoral Council.
- *The Commissions* are responsible for planning and development <u>in</u> a particular ministry, in light of the vision and direction set by the Pastoral Council.

The nine basic responsibilities of all Consultative Bodies at St. Mary Magdalen are: 1) Prayer, 2) Determine the ministry area's mission and vision, 3) Support the pastor and staff, 4) Ensure effective strategic planning, 5) Ensure adequate resources, 6) Manage resources effectively, 7) Determine and monitor the ministry area's programs and services, 8) Promoting the parish's public presence, 9) Assess its own performance."

Application and three-year commitment required. Training and leadership development for all members is provided and required in the Fall of each year. Each council or commission meets either monthly or quarterly September through June. See the enclosed sheet entitled "Pastoral Leadership Discernment Process" for gifts and qualifications needed.

Those who serve on a council or commission need to be a "*partner in our mission*", which includes attending Eucharist weekly with our community, committed to personal spiritual growth, serving in one or more ministries in the parish, and financially support the mission and ministries of the entire parish through the Sunday and Holyday envelopes on a regular basis (weekly giving). Every Fall, each partner household makes a sacrificial, financial pledge to support God's work at St. Mary Magdalen for the coming year. They fulfill their pledge throughout the following calendar year.
