CHRISTLIFE UPDATE, EUCHARISTIC ADORATION DATE CHANGE, RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS/CHILDREN

CHRISTLIFE UPDATE: As of August 20, we have a total of 50 people registered to participate in ChristLife as well as a team of 34 people. That brings the number to 84. Our goal is 200 people by the registration deadline which is August 31. This is a wonderful way to grow in your relationship with Jesus Christ and to get to know others whom you may have seen at church but don't really know. My team and I are excited about beginning ChristLife on September 8 from 6:45 pm to 9:15 pm with dinner included. Remember, it's free! We just ask for a commitment of your time. Be sure to invite others, whether Catholic or not, provided that they are at least 14 years old to join us. Everyone needs to register. We hope to put all the teens and single young adults together at separate tables.

Elizabeth Trexler, our ChristLife coordinator, asked me to consider renting a bus to transport those who don't drive or who don't drive at night. One of our parishioners, Will Albert, is a certified bus driver for the Gateway School District which uses STA (Student Transportation Association) as its bus company. When Will inquired about the cost of a van, ½ bus and full bus for us to rent, he said that all "charter" regardless of whether it is a van, ½ bus or full bus would be rented at the same price \$50.00/hour for a minimum of four hours. Tim Thorsen, (business manager) and I realize that at this time, this weekly charge is unaffordable with our current budget. I am asking those participants who registered to consider ride sharing. If you are coming to ChristLife and are willing to pick up one or more people, please leave your name with one of our two parish secretaries, Charlotte or Pat. If you need a ride to ChristLife please leave your name with either Charlotte or Pat. Hopefully, they can match the ones who are offering rides with the ones who need rides so that everyone who wants to go can go.

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION DATE CHANGE: As you know, our Eucharistic Adoration Day is typically the second Monday of each month at North American Martyrs Church beginning after the 8:00 am Mass and continuing until 8:00 pm. Since our ChristLife series is on every Monday night, we don't want a conflict with Eucharistic Adoration. As I presented this dilemma to the ChristLife team, they recommended that we temporarily move the Eucharistic Adoration to the second Wednesday of the month, beginning on September 10. I have cleared it with our Director of Religious Education, Donna Lew-Buechel, who will communicate these changes to her second grade and eighth grade teachers so that their students can come and adore the Blessed Sacrament as their religion class schedule allows. In summary, Eucharistic Adoration will be on the second Wednesday of the month (in place of the second Monday of the month) for the following dates: September 10, October 8, November 12, December 10, January 14 and February 11. To the parish ministries and organizations who ask two people from their group to represent them at Eucharistic Adoration, please make this change to your schedule.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS/CHILDREN: I am happy to announce that our RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) will begin on Wednesday, September 24 at 7:00 pm at the teacher's lounge of the school. It is open for all those who are unbaptized as well as those who may be baptized as a non-Catholic e.g. Protestant, and who would like to become Catholic. If there is anyone who is an adult and who has never been confirmed, you are also welcome to come. The RCIA is intended for adults, will be meeting weekly on Wednesday evenings (with some breaks for the holidays and holy days) and will extend until April 29. If you know someone who would benefit from attending RCIA, please invite them to come. For those who are children, and want to become baptized and/or who missed receiving their sacraments with their class or who may want to become Catholic, please call me and we can talk about it further so that I can direct you to either Donna Lew-Buechel or Diane Fleet.

Complete and return the necessary forms. Clearances for current volunteers are updated every 5 years and you will receive the necessary paperwork in the mail with instructions for completion. Once you have attended a Protecting God's Children Workshop, you are not required at this time by the Diocese of Pittsburgh to update or attend the workshop again.
