## **Freshman Course Request Worksheet**

*Completing this worksheet in advance will aid in the online registration process.*

*In order to request an honors level course, all incoming freshmen are required to meet the following criteria:*

- 1. 93 or above course average in 8<sup>th</sup> grade subject related college prep course work or 84 or above course average in 8<sup>th</sup> grade subject related honors level course work.*
- 2. History of subject area standardized test scores indicating success at the honors level*
- 3. Subject area departmental recommendation addressing work ethic, classroom maturity and skill level*

**All freshmen must register for the following six required core courses:**

- 1. English 9** (1 credit) *or* **English 9 H** (1 credit)
- 2. Algebra I** (1 credit) *or* **Geometry** (1 credit) *or* **Geometry H** (1 credit)
- 3. Physical Science** (1 credit) *or* **Biology** (1 credit) *or* **Biology H** (1 credit)
- 4. Geography** (.5 credit) *and* **Ancient History** (.5 credit)
- 5. Bible 9** (1 credit)
- 6. Wellness** (1 credit)
