8TH GRADE ELECTIVE COURSE OFFERINGS AT MJHS

Art

8th grade Art will work on drawing techniques such as perspective. We will also work on print making and painting. Students will be required to purchase class supplies, although supplies are not needed to begin class.

Band

8th grade band will continue to reinforce previously learned materials and increase their level of playing. Jazz Band is also offered for 7th & 8th grade groups. Students will also participate in solo and ensemble, and full group contest. All concerts are required attendance. In addition, students are required to purchase a concert polo and wear appropriate concert dress.

Chorus

Choral ensembles are essentially music teams except everyone is a starter. Self-discipline and a desire to sing is a requirement, not an option. Performance attendance is also required as the performance of the chorus is its primary function. There are three major concerts; fall, winter, and spring plus a competition at Six Flags in May. Each student must pass an individual audition before they are permitted to attend the competition at Six Flags. In addition, students are required to purchase a concert polo and wear appropriate concert dress.

Computer Software Basics

This course is designed to increase the student's opportunities to succeed in school work. Students will learn to use computers as tools in conjunction with related software and operating systems. Topics include Document production (reports: Unbound, MLA {used at SVHS}, letters, memos), spreadsheets, computer concepts/components, understanding Web/Internet (internet safety and continued career exploration, micro blogging with Edmodo, Webware programs for presentations (Prezi and Sliderocket). Software programs used: MS Word, MS Publisher, MS Excel, Adobe Photoshop, Moviemaker.
