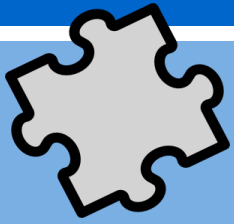

What's the Cost?

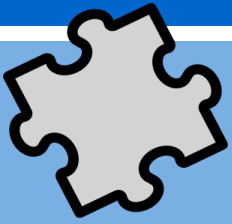

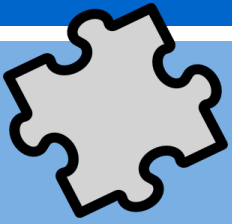
