



GED Testing Procedures

Examinees, by initialing beside each statement, you are verifying that you understand the testing procedures. If you have further questions, you may ask the GED Examiner or ABE Instructor.
The GED Testing site has the right to cancel the GED Tests if there are not enough applicants registered to take the test. I will be informed when the next available test will be.
PRIOR TO THE GED TEST I must pass the Official GED Practice Tests (OPT) prior to taking the GED.
I will register for the GED Tests by using the online registration process called the GEDWizard.
DURING THE GED TEST
I may not have the following personal items with me in the testing room: tote bags, purses, food items, textbooks, dictionaries, notebooks, book bags, supplies, scratch paper, jackets, coats, hats, or other items. GED testing and
will not be responsible for the items or items. If I bring these items into the testing room, I must leave them at a designated area. Should these items be found at my seat or on my person the GED test materials will be collected, and my test scores will not be valid. I will be required to leave the testing center. I may not reschedule to test without permission from the State GEDAdministrator.
Cell phones, pagers, and any other electronic devices are not allowed in the testing room. If these are found in my possession during testing and at my seat, I will not be permitted to retest for six (6) months. My test will cease and all papers will be collected.
I must have my state or government issued photo ID at each testing session.
The GED Test starts at in Room I must be seated and ready to test at this time. Late arrivals will not be permitted to test.
Restrooms are located ; snacks are located

FOLLOWING THE GED TEST
After testing, I understand that I may not discuss any questions or essay topic with anyone, including, but not limited to, my family, friends, or instructors. If I violate this guideline, all o
my scores will become invalid.
I may access my scores on the GEDWizard by logging onto the GEDWizard using my email address and GEDWizard password. I will select "My Score" tab to view my scores.
My scores should be posted at my GEDWizard "My Scores" within two weeks. If by the beginning of the third week, my scores have not been posted, I will call
When my tests are in the process of being scored, an "O" or "NS" (Not Scored) with a status o "Incomplete" will appear. If by the beginning of the third week, an "O" or "NS" still appears, will call
If I am not successful in passing the GED Tests with a minimum of 410 in each subject and a total of 2250 points, I may take each subject three times in a given year. Therefore, I may decide if it is necessary to take the entire tests over or just one or two subjects at a time. I realize that I will always keep my highest score in a given subject.
I understand that these guidelines are stated on the GEDWizard, and by submitting the GEDWizard form, I am verifying that I understand and will abide by these guidelines.
