
Directions to the New York State Fairgrounds

From the East or West: From the New York State Thruway (I-90), take exit 39 (Route 690). Follow Route 690 East to Exit 7 (Fairgrounds / Route 297). At the end of the exit, stay right onto Route 297. Make an immediate left turn into Fairgrounds Gate 2.

From the North or South: Follow Route 81. Follow signs to exit on Route 690 West and exit Route 690 at the Fairgrounds (Exit 39).

General Information & Rules

- 1. **Move in / Move Out:** Standard move-in days are Monday and Tuesday between 8:00 am and 8:00 pm. Special arrangements can be made with show secretary Charlotte Jaynes for move-in outside of those hours. Horses must move out no later than 9:00 a.m. on Monday, September 28.
- 2. **No Reservation Without Payment:** Flat Fee Deals, individual stall fees, camper fees and charges for shavings, feed and hay must be paid when submitting reservations. Without payment, NO stall reservations will be accepted and no shavings will be ordered or delivered. In U.S. dollars only.
- 3. **Scratches.** Any entry scratched from a class and NOT reported to the show office will be charged the class fee. SCRATCHES MUST BE MADE IN THE SHOW OFFICE.
- 4. **Stalls:** Stalls will be labeled with stall card when you arrive. No transfer of stalls or change of occupancy may be made without the approval of the show management. Exhibitors will be charged for the use of ANY stall that is used for any purpose. Shavings, feed and hay will be available on the grounds—contact the Show Office. You may show off your trailer, however no horses may stay in a trailer overnight.
- 5. Shavings: PLEASE PRE-ORDER YOUR BEDDING SO THAT IT WILL BE IN YOUR STALLS WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT THE FAIRGROUNDS.
- 6. **Barn Rules:** Please keep aisle ways clear. All manure must be disposed of in the bins provided by the fairgrounds or there will be a \$100 fine. If you remove a stall door, you must re-install it before you leave or be fined \$200. Any sharps used must be disposed of in the hazardous waste buckets that can be found in each barn. All AQHA rules regarding humane treatment of horses must be followed.
- 7. **Refunds:** There will be no refunds except with a vet certificate, which must have a current date and be signed by a licensed veterinarian.
- 8. **Splitting Classes**: Novice flat classes will be split if there are more than 16 entries in the class. All other flat classes will be split if there are more than 20 entries in the class. For Hunter Hack classes that are over these numbers, the fences portion will be held and the top entries will come back for the flat portion.
- Checks: There will be an NSF charge of \$30 for all checks which are returned for Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF). Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Checks should be made payable to "ESQHA".
 All checks must be payable in U.S. Funds.
- 10. **Coliseum Schooling & Longing:** THERE WILL BE NO LONGING IN THE COLISEUM. The Coliseum Overhang Arena, the 4-H Arena (outdoors) and the Dairy Barn Arena are available for longing. Longing is also available in the ring behind the Main Barn and in the area behind the Swine Barn.
- 11. **Small Fry and Leadline:** Small Fry classes are open to exhibitors 11 years of age and younger. Leadline classes are open to exhibitors 7 years of age and younger.
- 13. **Circuit Awards:** Circuit Awards will be given for every AQHA class and will be based on a composite of all AQHA udges' placings. All circuit awards or other awards given out must be claimed at the horse show. No awards will be shipped.
- 14. **Health Requirements:** All horses must meet the following health requirements. New York horses must present a negative Coggins test dated during the current year or the previous year. Horses stabled outside New York must present a negative Coggins test dated within 12 months and a health certificate dated within 30 days of your arrival. All horses must show a current Rabies inoculation certificate. Papers checked.
- 15. **Prize Money & Payback Rules:** Cash prizes in AQHA classes will be based on the combined scores of all class judges. Money will only be paid only if there are five or more horses in a class. No money will be paid if there are less than 5 horses entered in a class. Money will be paid as follows: For \$500 classes, 1st \$200, 2nd \$150, 3rd \$100, 4th \$50. For \$300 classes, 1st \$100, 2nd \$80, 3rd \$65, 4th \$55. For \$200 classes, 1st \$75, 2nd \$60, 3rd \$50, 4th \$15. Prize money checks will be mailed within 30 days after the show, provided that all of the exhibitor's checks for entry payments, stalls & campers have cleared the bank and the exhibitor has provided a social security number. **No paybacks will be deducted from entry fees in the show office.**
- 16. **Ties:** The judge whose last name (and then first name) is first in the alphabet will be the tie-breaker judge. The second tie-breaker judge will be the judge whose last name (and then first name) is second in the alphabet..
