

Health Care Options for Your Children

Free & Low-Cost Health Care Programs

There are many free or low-cost health programs for newborns, children and teens. The programs are:

Child Health and Disability Prevention Program

Medi-Cal for Children

Healthy Families

Kaiser Cares for Kids



These programs are for children from birth to their young adult years. Each program has its own rules about who can enroll or join. The size of your family, your family income and other factors are reviewed. Don't think you won't be able to enroll your children! Take the first step . . . San Diego Kids Health Assurance Network (SD-KHAN)

This is a free referral service for families who need help finding and applying for free or low-cost medical and dental care for children and youth.

Mothers & Newborns

There are special programs to help women during pregnancy and after child-birth. It's important to get your baby off to a healthy start in life!

Medi-Cal for Pregnant Women

Who can join: Pregnant women can get services during and after pregnancy.

AIM

Who can join: Pregnant women (not more than 30 weeks pregnant at the time of the application). The baby of a woman who was enrolled in AIM is covered from birth to age two.
