Welcome to the Killarney – Shebanoning Outdoor Environmental Education Centre (KSOEEC)! We offer curriculum based outdoor and heritage education programming. Our programs provide opportunities for students to learn about healthy living, child and youth stewardship, community studies, aboriginal teachings, ecological and environmental studies from elementary school, through high school and beyond. The centre is based at 8 St. Paul Street in the scenic port community of Killarney on the northeastern shore of Georgian Bay. The centre is on 7 acres of private land and adjacent to 1000's of acres of wilderness containing the famous white quartzite ridges of the La Cloche Mountains. Partnerships with the municipality of Killarney and Killarney Provincial Park cap off this rich and unique educational experience.
