The Keynote Address will be given by Frank Yiannas.

As Vice-President of Food Safety, Frank Yiannas oversees all food safety, as well as other public health functions, for the world's largest food retailer, Wal-Mart. Frank's scope of responsibilities includes food safety oversight of Wal-Mart's stores, Neighborhood Markets, and Sam's Clubs. Training and education of thousands of Associates, hundreds of food suppliers, and a number of critical regulatory compliance issues also come under his purview. Prior to joining Wal-Mart in 2008, Frank was the Director of Safety & Health for the Walt Disney World Company, where he worked for 19 years. In 2001, under his tenure, Walt Disney World received the prestigious Black Pearl Award for corporate excellence in food safety by the International Association for Food Protection.

As a frequent speaker at national and international conferences, Frank is known for his ability to build partnerships and for his innovative approaches to food safety. In 2008, Frank was given the Collaboration Award by the US Food and Drug Administration. He is the 2007 recipient of the NSF International Lifetime Achievement Award for Leadership in Food Safety. Frank is also a Past President of the International Association for Food Protection (IAFP) and the current Chair of the Food Allergy and Anaphylaxis Network's Board of Directors.

An introduction will be provided by Professor Chris Griffith, Editor of the *British Food Journal* and Head of the Food Research and Consultancy Unit at the University of Wales Institute, Cardiff, followed by the lecture.

Refreshments will be provided, during which time delegates will have the chance to network.
