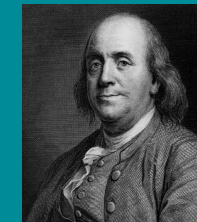


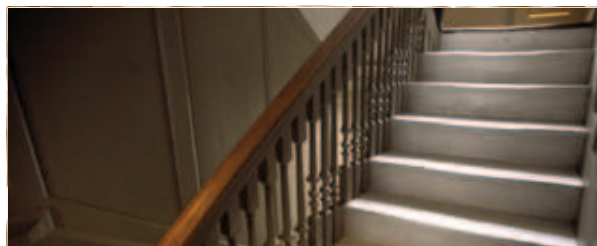

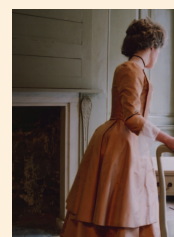
Please help us maintain this priceless building and advance its educational mission.

For nearly sixteen years, between 1757 and 1775, Benjamin Franklin - scientist, diplomat, philosopher, inventor, Founding Father of the United States and more, called 36 Craven Street home.

Here he progressed his passion for *science*, from fuel efficient stoves to electricity; *invention*, creating the Glass Armonica, an instrument for which Mozart and Beethoven composed; and *letters*, writing treatises, articles and spoofs. Though unable to reconcile Colonial and Crown interests, he fostered a special Anglo-American relationship that remains today.
