



Nepal: Development and Social Change **Nepal: Pre-visa Form**

All students on this program will be required to have an Indian tourist visa and a Nepali student visa for this program. The Indian tourist visa is contingency plan. You will be provided instructions for this process in July for fall programs, and December for spring programs.

In order to start the approval process for the Nepali visa, these forms will be submitted to our in-country partners to create support letters needed when you apply for your student visa. This form must be submitted with your Confirmation Materials. You will apply for the Indian tourist visa online. No paperwork is needed for that at this time.

COMMON *MISTAKES* OF PAST APPLICANTS

- **Pencil:** All official documents should always be filled out with blue or black ink, ballpoint pens. Please do not use a gel pen.
- **Streaking printer:** Please print on a high quality printer using black ink.
- **Bad penmanship:** Remember that being granted a visa is a privilege; do what you can to make it easier for the Immigration staff reviewing your application. Use BLOCK letters for this application.
- **Not following instructions:** if you have questions, please call!
