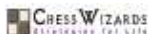

Financial Assistance Policy

The Menomonee Club offers assistance for all programs based on financial need. The amount of financial assistance granted is determined by a calculation that includes your family's annual income and the number of dependents in your household.

In order to receive assistance, we must have the following items on file*:

1. Financial Assistance Application (once per session)
2. A copy of your most recent 1040 federal tax form (once per school year)
3. Annual Family Information Form (once per school year)
4. Current session's Activity Registration Form (once per session)

Please note, all forms must be received 3 weeks prior to the start of each program session to be considered. All forms must be COMPLETE; partially filled forms will not be accepted. The assistance application for the current session must be submitted by the posted deadline. All applications received after the deadline will be reviewed in the order they are received and there is no guarantee that funds will be available.

Once we receive ALL forms, we will contact you about the amount of financial assistance we can give. If your application is late, your child cannot attend the class/ activity until we process the application.

Your full amount due MUST be paid by the end of the current session/camp day/camp week. If the amount is not paid in full, you will not be eligible for further assistance.

You may register for multiple classes, but only two classes per child each session will be considered for assistance. Financial aid ranges from 55% to 90% of each class. Funds may not be transferred from one child to another. Even with financial assistance, we will expect you to pay some amount.

Attendance Expectations

Good attendance is expected for all activities. Poor attendance may disqualify families from future assistance. If you need to cancel a class for any reason, our Club refund policy applies. Please see the full refund policy in our brochures and online at www.menomoneeclub.org. Note that even if you never attend a class, without proper cancellation you are responsible for the full amount due and will not be awarded future assistance until your balance is paid.

Menomonee Annual Membership

Dues are valid for one calendar year.

All membership fees are valid for one calendar year (12 months) from the time you register. It is important that our office has a current record of all information: health information, addresses, cell phones, blue jean styles...things are always changing! With a membership, participant(s) receive \$45 off every class they register for (\$25 off holiday programs). Members are also entitled to one Game Room day per week. The Game Room is at The Clubhouse and is open Monday-Friday 2:30-6:00pm. See pg. 30 for more details and rules.

Paperwork Required for New Members

Each year, we require new members to submit the Family Information Form. If signing up for programs, the season Activity Registration must also be completed in full. Membership dues are paid once per year.

Menomonee Guest Policy

The Clubhouse Game Room is organized for members only. However, if you wish to send a guest with your child, please call the Club ahead of time for approval. If space is available, each member can have up to three guest visits per year. There is a \$10 guest fee which includes use of the Game Room. It is extremely difficult to authorize a guest for a scheduled class or event, but you may call the Club to see if there is space available. If approved, there will be a class or event fee plus the \$10 guest fee. We would appreciate any emergency information you can provide, along with a signed release by the parent of the guest or member.

Menomonee Refund Policy

If you are not accepted into a program, you will receive a full refund. The Menomonee Club will also give a refund or credit minus a \$25 administrative fee prior to the first day of a program session. A 50% credit will be given during the first week of a program session, or during the first week of team practice (only if withdrawal from the program does not bring enrollment below the minimum number of students required to offer the class). All credits expire one year from the issue date. No credits or refunds will be given after the first week of the session. No credits or refunds will be issued for non-member program increased fees, in the event the child joins the club later in the year.

Instructors

Although it rarely happens, The Menomonee Club reserves the right to change or substitute instructors.

Cancellation of Programs

Unfortunately, we occasionally have to cancel a scheduled program due to insufficient enrollment. We strive to offer such a varied number of classes each season that sometimes one may not book up to the capacity we need. We reserve the right to cancel a program if that is the case. The enrolled participants will be called as soon as that decision is made, and a full refund will be issued.

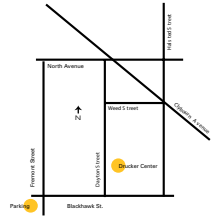

#4 Once children have signed in at the Clubhouse they cannot leave unless accompanied by a parent, guardian, or staff member. The only exception to this rule is if written permission is on file from a parent or guardian.

#5 Behavior in the Game Room must be courteous and members must share all equipment.

#6 All members must be picked up from the Game Room no later than 6:00pm. For classes ending after 6:00pm, members must be picked up promptly as class ends.

#7 When dropping off or picking up children, parents are asked to double park only on the east side of North Park Ave. (so that cars face north). Please do not block the crosswalks for the safety of the children.

#8 Please do not leave your car unattended - either with children or a purse - when dropping off or picking up children. If parents have an emergency, it may be possible for a staff member to walk a child from the Clubhouse to your car. Simply call us!
