1) Ten hours of service in the home:

This is doing tasks for which you are not currently responsible. Paid chores do not count.

- a. Raking leaves
- b. Shoveling snow
- c. Spending less time on the computer or watching TV
- d. Spending more quality time with your family

2) Ten hours of service to your Church and Parish Community, school and neighborhood:

This is an opportunity to serve your community

- a. Helping neighbors with snow, leaves and garbage removal.
- b. Going to the store for grandparents and elderly neighbors.
- c. To help in the parish in the different ministries. (Look in the Bulletin)
- d. Serving as altar servers, helping with the little children of God, as a choir member.
- e. Volunteering in hospitals, nursing homes, food banks.

- a. Private prayer (praying alone)
- b. Reading the Sacred Scriptures (the Bible)
- c. Reading books on the lives of the Saints.
- d. Visit Church
- e. Pray the Rosary
- f. Stations of the Cross (available every Friday during Lent)
- g. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament 3:00 to 6:00p.m. (available the third Tuesday, year round)
