Fall 2014 Commencement Ceremony

When: Saturday, December 13, 2014

Location: Concordia University Arena (Gym)

- 10:00 11:30 a.m. Commencement Ceremony. All graduates are expected to remain seated until the entire ceremony has ended and faculty have recessed.

Spring 2015 Commencement Ceremony

When: Saturday, May 2, 2015

Location: Bren Events Center, UCI Campus

Students may invite as many guests as they would like.

- 4:55 p.m. Commencement procession will begin. Faculty

 MBA, Coaching and Athletic Administration, Teaching
 Credential/Regional Cohort MAED. Names will be read using
 cards. Students may sit with whomever they wish within the
 groupings.
- 5:00-6:30 p.m. Graduate Commencement. All graduates are expected to remain seated until the entire ceremony has ended and faculty have recessed.

APPLICATION FEE

The following application fee covers the administrative time needed to process the application, run a degree audit, track the student's progress and post the degree to the student's transcript. It also covers the cost of ordering and mailing the diploma. This fee is required even if you are not walking.

\$175 - September 13 - October 31

HONORS

Graduate students are not eligible for honors. In academe, being admitted and completing a graduate degree is considered an honor.

REGALIA - \$55 + Postage and Handling

Graduates will be responsible for ordering and paying for their own regalia (cap, gown, hood and tassel). Graduates will be informed via email when to order regalia.

DEGREES AND DIPLOMAS

All Degrees will be posted 4-6 weeks after the end of the Fall term (December 12th) and students will be notified by email. You may order transcripts reflecting your degree at this time, Transcript Request Form. Diplomas will then be ordered and will take an additional 6-8 weeks to be delivered to your home address. Please be sure to keep your home address current in MyRecords.

Exit Loan Counseling
