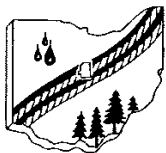

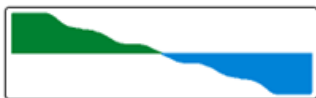

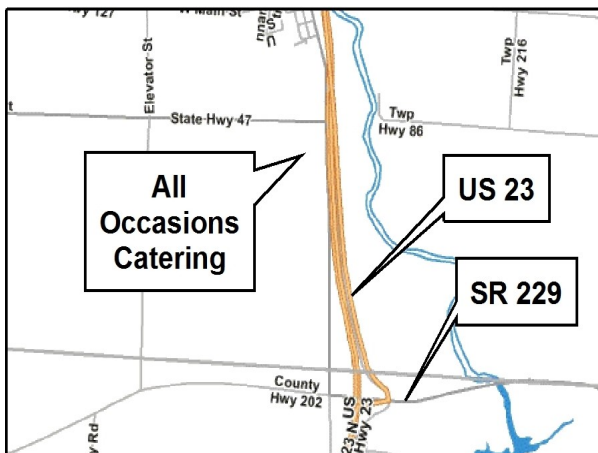
New this year is the opportunity to earn your Agricultural Fertilizer Applicator Certification.
