Stream crossings assessment is included in LP's Annual Reports. A condition in work permits issued to LP state "only clean snow and ice may be used as fill to cross creeks and streams. Prior approval must be obtained from the local Supervising Officer before a log fill or any other method of crossing a stream is undertaken".
