This one day training course will show you how to design your garden so that you are maximising your growing potential, including growing vegetables on a rotational system, sowing and planting techniques and successful cropping. The course is aimed at volunteers working on community projects.

This course will:

- Show a way of planning a vegetable garden including keeping records to use in future years and crop rotation
- Show good horticultural technique regarding sowing seed, growing on and potting
- Discuss timing for sowing and planting

It will also cover:

- Pest and Diseases
- Controlling weeds
- Companion planting



The venue is the base for Devon Garden Services run by Mark Brown. The site overlooks the city of Exeter with fantastic views of rolling countryside to the north. There is a large enclosed barn, polytunnel with propagating bench, and good toilet facilities.

The event is free to HogCO members, and £15 (non refundable) for other organisations.
