SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION PROCESS:

The scholarship committee is composed of board members of The Portland Foundation. The committee reviews all applications turned in by the deadline. The scholarship committee will not consider late and/or incomplete applications. If you have any questions regarding the completion of the application, please do not hesitate to contact the Foundation office at (260) 726-4260.

Each student is numerically "scored" based upon the following criteria:

- 1. Academic accomplishment
- 2. Financial need and resources available to the student
- 3. Activity and involvement in school, work and the community

Once the members of the scholarship committee have scored each student, the individual scores are totaled and averaged to reach a composite score. Then each student is ranked according to his or her average. The full Board of Trustees of The Portland Foundation then reviews the results and determines the number of scholarships to be awarded based on available income and the number of applicants.

Those students who plan to attend a program of 4 years or longer are ranked separately from those students planning to attend a program of 1-3 years.
