H.S. (Bert) Chase: At an early age Bert and his family moved to Peru, whose rich history and archaeology inspired a lifelong interest in the relationship between architecture and spiritual influences in everyday life. Early in his career he met Rudolf Steiner's profound indications for architecture - these changed the course of his life. Bert's architectural practice in Vancouver, B.C. has served anthroposophical initiatives throughout North America and Hawaii. He has written, lectured and taught extensively on anthroposophical subjects and Rudolf Steiner's arts impulse.

Rev. Jonah Evans grew up in Sacramento, California and attended the Sacramento Waldorf School. Later, he received a bachelor's degree in Psychology from California State University in Sacramento. He then attended the Seminary of The Christian Community in Chicago and Stuttgart, Germany. In 2008 he was consecrated as a priest. He has worked as a community priest in Johannesburg, South Africa, Spring Valley, NY and currently in Toronto. He is married and has two lovely daughters.

Regine Kurek: Founder and Director of Arscura - School for Art and Biography in the Healing and Social Fields in Toronto, Regine has worked as a teacher and art facilitator here and abroad for many years. She has just returned from an extended stay in Madeira. At the moment she is interested in forging new connections between art, nature and the social realm in areas of the world where nature might invite a 'christening'. She is interested to work on such projects with colleagues.
