The I-20/DS-2019 is a Certificate of Eligibility to obtain the F-1/J-1 visa. The Applicants may submit the FCF and supporting documents at any time during their admission process. The ISSS office will issue the appropriate immigration documents only after the applicant (1) has been formally admitted to FAU, and (2) completed this form and submitted acceptable financial supporting documents.
