LiUNA Local 183 Scholarship Trust Fund

The goal of the LiUNA Local 183 Scholarship Trust Fund is to assist members, the children and grandchildren of Local 183 members and retirees, in obtaining a high quality post-secondary education.

Provided that the Scholarship Applicant meets the foregoing requirements, and the member, parent or grandparent is in good standing with LiUNA Local 183; all on time and properly completed applications will be received for review.

The independent academic committee will review all submissions based on the criteria established. Disabled applicants should include a brief note indicating their disability.

All candidates will be notified in writing of the decision of the committee, and this will be mailed to the address provided on the Application. After all notifications have been made, an awards dinner will be held in honour of the successful applicants, at which time the Scholarships will be formally presented.

Awards will be made to successful candidates subject to administrative requirements established by the Trustees and amounts awarded may be subject to variation based on the availability of the Fund.

Except as necessary for the procedures described herein, all applications and information will remain strictly confidential.

Applicants must be registered as a full time attendee and maintain appropriate academic standings to receive future payments.

Eligibility & Rules

Any student who has graduated or who will be graduating from an Ontario High School or an equivalent program and will be attending a recognized post-secondary institution, such as a College or University in the coming school year, and is a member, the child or grandchild of a Local 183 member or a retiree in good standing, is eligible to apply for consideration.

Please note that anyone who was awarded a Local 183 Scholarship in the past is not eligible to apply again, even if the full amount of the past award was not received. Anyone who has applied for a Local 183 scholarship in the past and was not awarded is eligible to re-apply. If approved, the Scholarship will be awarded for the years remaining on your planned program.

Award

A number of scholarships will be awarded on an annual basis to successful applicants as chosen by the Fund's Independent Academic Committee. The Scholarship is as follows:

- Maximum of \$2,500 per annum
- For a period of up to four (4) continuous years provided the successful applicant remains in full-time attendance at a post-secondary institution and maintains a passing grade in all subjects. Total value of the scholarship over the four-year period will not exceed \$10,000.

Areas of study which require less time to complete will only receive the award for the actual length of the program. The total value will not be averaged over a shortened period of time.

Criteria

An Independent Academic Committee comprised of professionals of both public and private institutions and other prominent persons, will review all applications received.

Instructions

Grading Criteria

Scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- Essay Submission;
- Involvement in community activities including: multi-cultural, religious, athletics and any other organizations;
- Paid or volunteer work experience (with references) not including volunteer work done for school credits;
- Secondary school or University / College marks and academic achievement;
- Life Experience;
- Please note at least one (1) scholarship per year will be reserved for a qualified applicant with a disability, if such an application is received;
- Any additional information.

Submission Instructions

Please take these steps to ensure that your application is received in full. Only complete applications that are received on time will be considered:

- Fill out the general info card on page 5 and attach any documents pertaining to community activity, paid work or any relevant information.
- Please completely answer the essay portion, typed and double-spaced, on one of the topics.
- Certified **original** academic transcript from the Secondary school, College or University you last attended (including final marks - number of credits will not be accepted). **Please note only original transcripts will be accepted.**
- Letter of acceptance from the College or University you will be attending in the upcoming academic year.
- Any other relevant documentation such as references, awards, etc.

Essay Format

Complete an essay on one of the topics listed. Each essay should be a maximum of 500 words and must include information gathered from research as well as personal opinion. Please type and double space your essay, if typing is not possible neatly print and double space your work.

Each essay should be written in a standard format consisting of 5 paragraphs:

- 1 introductory paragraph
- 3 body paragraphs - each reflecting a different point on the topic.
- 1 concluding paragraph

Please complete 1 of the 4 topics listed below:

- 1** In your opinion, why are second-generation immigrants to Canada not choosing careers related to apprenticeships or skilled trades? Is skills training well supported in our school system?
- 2** In the Province of Ontario, are careers in construction, both residential and commercial, directions that are easily understood by students planning for their futures?
- 3** If Ontario is to remain a strong industrial centre, what advice would you give to your Provincial Government?
- 4** In your opinion, what industry has made the largest contribution to the Canadian economy over the last few years? Is this an industry that you would consider as you plan for your future?
