It's easy to participate!

Option #1 - employees fundraise for JA

- Company recruits employee teams of five bowlers
- Each team member raises at least \$125
- \$75 lane fee per team (usually paid by company)
- Teams celebrate their efforts on one of the listed bowling dates

Option #2 - company fundraises for JA

- Company recruits employee teams of five bowlers
- Company sponsors teams at \$700 per team (includes \$75 lane fee)
- Teams celebrate their efforts on one of the listed bowling dates

Option #3 - be a JA bigBowl sponsor

- Sponsors will reach highly engaged business professionals via causerelated marketing opportunities
