## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. **Eligibility**: Artists must have a connection with St Margaret's and Berwick Grammar School. This includes past or current students, parents and staff.
- 2. Artists may submit up to two works (recent or past). Due to space constraints, we may limit the number of works displayed per artist.
- 3. Artworks can be two or three dimensional in any style or medium (with the exception of installations).
- 4. Works that require hanging must not weigh more than 20kg.

1 March – Thursday 10 March 2016.

- 5. Artists are responsible for the transport and insurance of their artworks.
- 6. Delivery and collection: All artworks are to be delivered and collected on the set dates below: Delivery: All works must be delivered by Tuesday 23 February at 5.30 pm Collection: All works must be collected during school hours (8.30 am 4.30 pm) on Friday 11 March. If you are unable to deliver or collect works at this time please contact Heather Landman during school hours to discuss other arrangements. Consignment of exhibited artwork is limited to the period Tuesday
- 7. **Consignment and sale of artworks.** Artists will have the opportunity to sell artworks if desired at the exhibition. All artwork remains the property of the artist until sold. Payment for the works will need to be made at the exhibition.
  - It is the responsibility of artists represented by other galleries to inform and advise them of their participation in the St Margaret's School Community Art Exhibition.
- 8. **Exhibition Promotion**: St Margaret's and Berwick Grammar School will promote the exhibition via local media, as well as through its own publications and social media networks. All images used will acknowledge the artists. **Please indicate if you do not wish your work or image to be featured in future school publications**.
- 9. **Artists' Promotion:** Artists may supply their own promotional material, directly related to their own artistic practice. DL flyers or business cards may be displayed with exhibited works.
