APPLICATION DEADLINES

May 1st - Fall semester (August - December) & November 1st - Spring Semester (January - May) Sacramento City College is authorized under the Student Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) to enroll non-immigrant students www.ice.gov/sevis. All Non-English documents must be accompanied by an English Translation.

Financial support

Official bank letter verifying \$21,601.00 USD for one year of study. \$3,000 is required for each additional dependent. If you have a U.S. sponsor, submit USCIS Affidavit of Support Form I-134 (download at www.uscis.gov) and supporting documents. ONLY original bank letter within 6 months of instructional start date is accepted. (NO photocopy).

- a) Official high school diploma and transcripts No scanned or photocopied transcripts will be accepted. (If you are currently in your final year of high school, request a letter signed by your Principal certifying the expected graduation month, date and year.) Be sure to request a final document to verify completion.
 - b) Official college transcripts (if applicable). Oversea college transcripts must be evaluated by the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES) http://www.naces.org/ or Association of International Credential Evaluators, Inc. (AICE) http://www.aice-eval.org/.
- \$50.00 non-refundable application fee payable to "Sacramento City College" in a form of a check, money order or cashier's check (do not send cash) payable by a United States bank. Print the student's name on the face of the check including the SCC ID#, if available. Applications will not be processed without a receipt of payment.
- One small photograph (passport size) with your name printed on back.

TRANSFER-IN F-1 STUDENTS who have been attending school in the U.S. are required to submit the additional items #6-8 below.

- 6. SCC Transfer-In Form must be completed by you and signed by your International Advisor PDSO/DSO.
- *7*. Copy of most recent I-94, VISA, and Passport (front & back). Original VISA and Passport must be verified in-office upon arrival.
 - **8.** Copy of **current school's I-20** and all other SEVIS I-20s.

Upon acceptance, provide proof of **Health Insurance** with coverage date to the SCC Health Services. For the LRCCD/SCC health insurance, visit https://studentinsurance.wellsfargo.com

Tuberculosis Clearance certification is also required and can be taken at SCC Health Services. Pay at the Business Office and bring the \$5 fee receipt to the SCC Health Services in RHN 125.

ASSESSMENT TESTS: SSC ESL/ESSAY or ENGLISH and MATH TESTS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL NEW STUDENTS. Assessment in these subjects will show educational strengths and needs and can provide useful information for planning a course of study at Sacramento City College or in transferring to a 4- year University. COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS OVERSEAS: SCC does not evaluate foreign transcripts nor is credit granted for foreign coursework. Students with a degree (AA/AS, BA/BS, or higher) from a school outside the United States must have their foreign transcript evaluated by a National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES) approved independent agency. The evaluation must specify equivalency to an AA/AS or a BA/BS or higher from a U.S. regionally accredited college. See ISC Academic Counselor/Coordinator to get information about foreign transcript (If applicable)

<u>HEALTH INSURANCE</u>: ALL International Students are required to have Health Insurance that covers them while living/studying in the U.S. Health care is extremely expensive, and there are <u>no free</u> medical facilities to so see a doctor. F-1 International Student can purchase health insurance through LRCCD-Los Rios Community College District (*recommended provider*) available at: https://studentinsurance.wellsfargo000.com OR show proof of comparable plan (translated in English with coverage dates), if you have an existing one . A "hold" will be placed in your record failure to show proof of health insurance and will prevent you from registering classes. "*Travel insurance*" plans are not acceptable.

<u>HOUSING INFORMATION</u>: It is the student's responsibility to find housing in the U.S. SCC/ISC does not provide housing or housing families for F-1 International Student. However, we may have information about privately owned apartments/businesses that might be helpful. Contact ISC, if needed.

TRANSPORTATION: SCC is, by far, the only community college within the Losrios District that has a light rail station on campus. <u>APPLICATION REVIEW PROCESS</u> Once all required documents have been reviewed, ISC will contact you with the final decision within two weeks. If you are currently in F-1 visa status and transferring to SCC from an institution within the U.S., ISC will request your SEVIS I-20 within 5 days from your SEVIS release date, determined by your current school.

HELPFUL TIPS: For overseas applicants, it is advisable to submit all documents at least four to six months prior to first day of instruction to avoid lengthy visa delays and to be assured of admission. Pay I-901 fee, arrange American Consulate visa interview, and plan to attend the Mandatory F-1 Student Orientation. Once admitted, to ensure the availability of 12 units required to maintain status, you can arrange an appointment by phone or e-mail, while overseas, to an International Counselor for suggested classes allowing you to register classes prior to arriving in the United States. *Contact ISC for details* (916)558-2486.

*Subject to increase without prior notice. All tuition fees are subject to change upon approval by College Board of Trustees, the Chancellor, and California legislature. F-1 students are required to take twelve units per semester. Summer session is optional. Withdrawals "W's" do not count towards 12 units to maintain the F-1 status.
