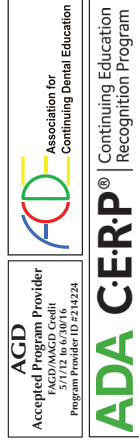

## Objectives and Overview

The 4-Day Course is specifically designed to help periodontists prepare for the oral exam (Part II) for certification by the American Board of Periodontology. The course begins with two and a half days of comprehensive literature review and update followed by one and a half days of mock oral board exams.

The two and a half days of literature review and update cover:

- ✓ Current concepts – particularly as they relate to management of patients with advanced periodontal disease
- ✓ New developments and a general update in periodontics
- ✓ Systemic diseases' influences on periodontal disease, patient management, and periodontal medicine
- ✓ Management of office emergencies and diagnosis of oral lesions

***Oral board exam preparation is more important than ever. For the past five years, the average annual passing rate for the oral exam was lower than the average annual passing rate for the qualifying (written) exam.***

This observation process is a key benefit of the overall mock oral board exam process. Periodontists who have passed the oral board exam report that the mock oral board process played a key role in improving their oral test-taking skills and boosting their self-confidence.

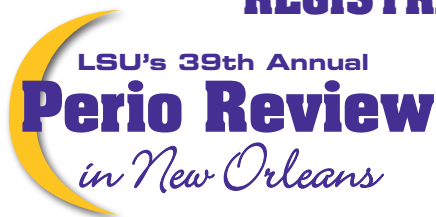
