









- Q: Do I need to complete the FAFSA?
- A: Yes, students should complete the FAFSA in order to determine eligibilty for need based scholarships.
- Q: How do I upload my FAFSA Form?
- A: Visit the webite for details:https://fafsa.ed.gov/
- Q: How long does the award process take?
- A: Approximately a month after notification of award.





- Q: Do I need to complete more than one application?
- A: No, there is only one application
- Q: Can I receive more than one scholarship?

A: Yes, students may receive more than one scholarship.







- Q: I completed my application early, do I get special consideration?
- A: No, however there is a priorty deadline for students who would like to be considered for specific scholarships.
- Q: I have a 4.0 GPA, why haven't I received a scholarship?
- A: Bauer Scholarships are competitive and we have many 4.0 students. There are several varibales considered during the selection process. GPA is only one aspect.
- Q: How do I increase my chances?
- A: Complete the entire application and provide as much information as possible.







- Q: Do I need to be in a Bauer organization?
- A: No, however some scholarships do require specific organization memberships for consideration.
- Q: Are scholarships available for part-time and/ graduate students?
- A: Yes, there are scholarships for part-time as well as graduate students.





- Q: Are scholarships awarded in the spring?
- A: Yes, there are a limited number scholarships awarded in the spring semester.
- Q: If I recieve a scholarship will I qualify for in-state- tuition wavier?
- A: Yes, students who receive a competetive scholarship receive tuition waviers.





- Q: Why haven't I received any feedback?
- A: Due to the high number of scholarship applicants and growing number of scholarships, only the students who are selected to receive scholarships receive notification.
