

Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered. Entries must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. You must waive the signature requirement for delivery services. if applicable.

Limit of 10 dogs per envelope. No hand deliveries can be accepted in the first 24 hours.

All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. Please check your entries!

"After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (40 run maximum) will be maintained for this trial once it has closed on August 6. The waiting list will be active until its deadline — Monday, August 27, 6:00 pm CDT. Any dogs that are entered in this trial at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by dogs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a dog is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trial. Entry fees for dogs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

Class Description

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. **Dogs must** be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.

Obstacles

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Weave pole spacing is 24". Contacts are rubberized.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all Golden Retrievers fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Running Order

Jump order and class order will be determined at closing. Regular and Preferred will be run together at each height.

AKC Jump Height Cards

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. An official AKC Jump Height Card is defined as either a permanent jump height card, a valid temporary jump height form, copies of two different measuring forms (placing the dog in the same height class) dated on or after the dog's second birthday, or copies of three different measuring forms (two of which place the dog in the same height class) on or after the dog's second birthday. All dogs (except those jumping 24" or 26") without jump height cards/forms must be measured/ wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class; this measurement will be valid for the weekend of trials only. If a Volunteer Measuring Official or an Agility Field Rep is present, all dogs without a valid jump height card/form must be measured at some time during the trial. If the dog cannot be measured by the VMO prior to running, it must be measured by the judge before its first run. You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. Move-ups

MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CDT, Tuesday, August 28. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

If you finish a title at the CCTC Trials on Aug 31 - Sep 2 or the GRC-GSL Trial on Sep 3, you may move up in class for the GRCA trial.

Electronic Timing

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

Trial Information

The site will be open at 6:00 am on Tuesday, September 4.

Trial hours are 7:00 am until 30 minutes after the completion of judging.

Ring size: 2 rings, 90' x 110'.

The arena is air-conditioned with indoor restrooms. Please bring crates, water for your dogs and clean up supplies. Ex-pens are permitted. All crates and ex-pens must be placed on a mat thick enough to protect the floor from sharp corners or edges.

Food service is available at the trial site. Only small coolers for treats are allowed; no other outside food is permitted.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The <u>safety of the dogs</u> is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- The Golden Retriever Club of America may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Since <u>bitches in season</u> are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the clubs will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive <u>written notification</u> of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before the trial commences.
- The clubs will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee for <u>injured dogs or handlers</u>. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trial and a veterinarian's or doctor's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committees, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The Golden Retriever Club of America has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.
- Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and <u>must include the signed</u>
 <u>Agreement and Rules</u>. <u>Junior Handlers</u> must enter their JH# and complete back of form.
 Include only AKC titles on entries.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, regardless of whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- The Golden Retriever Club of America does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$10 returned check fee.
- No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
- The Golden Retriever Club of America, its Boards and Members, and Nestlé Purina Farms and its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.
- Purina Event Center is open from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm.
- All buildings are NON-SMOKING. Smoking is permitted outside in designated areas.
- Dogs cannot be left in the Purina Farms Event Center or the outdoor grooming tent over night.

 All crates must be marked with a contact name and phone number.

Notice to Exhibitors (cont)

- Exhibitor and visitor parking for cars will be located on blacktop parking lots in front of the Purina Event Center at no charge. Vehicles limited to one parking space. Additional parking will be available at the Visitor's Center.
- No cones allowed in parking areas. Saving or blocking of spaces will not be allowed.
- No parking in roadways or next to any building. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AT OWNER'S EXPENSE.
- No ex-pens or crates are allowed on the blacktop but are allowed on grass areas, but not adjacent to the main building.
- No one is permitted anywhere that is marked "Employees Only" and/or "No Admittance." These are separate divisions of Purina and not part of the show grounds.
- No spectators or dogs are allowed on the second floor of the Purina Event Center.
- No baby strollers are allowed inside the building.


All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel. RV and trial grounds. Any damages to motels, RV sites or the trial site can result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee.

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds and RV sites are considered within the trial grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room/site and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial-giving club and its Event Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel or RV facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

Directions

From North/East/South: Take I-44 to Gray Summit/Hwy 100 Exit 253. Turn east on Hwy 100. After approximately ½ mile, turn left on MM. Entrance to Purina Farms is approximately 1 mile on left.

From West: Take I-70 to Hwy 47, Exit 193. Take Hwy 47 south to Hwy 100. Continue on 100 to I-44 east. Take I-44 east one exit to Gray Summit. Follow directions above.



RV Parking

Parking will become available for Golden Retriever agility trial exhibitors at noon on Sunday, September 2. All RVs must vacate the site by noon, Sunday, September 9 unless other arrangements have been made. The fee for parking is \$225 for September 3 through September 9.

RV parking will be on gravel surfaces. All hookups include electricity; however extension cords may be required for connection. Water will be available; however "Y" connections and extra hose may be required. All sites in the Event Center lot will include sewer, however some sites will require a long sewer hose to connect. Septic pump-out will be arranged for a 2 mid-week service calls for those parked on the lower RV lot. Additional information and sign-up will be available after arrival. A dump station is available at the facility; however please arrive with empty tanks if at all possible.

Each RV will have an assigned space, RV parking will be limited to the spaces reserved, with no day-use RV parking available.

Please arrive between the hours of 10 am and 6 pm to ensure assistance in finding your assigned space. A map of assigned spaces will be made available for early or late arrivals, however anyone parking in an incorrect space will be moved.

Date received will be tracked to ensure special requests are met whenever possible. Confirmations will be sent via email only.

Reservations may be cancelled without penalty through August 1, 2012. No refunds will be available after that date. Please use email to cancel any confirmed reservation.

There are approximately 100 RV spaces available at the facility. A waiting list will be maintained should more requests be received than can be immediately filled. Notification of waiting list status will be sent as soon as it is determined. Final determination of site availability will be made between August 6 and August 15. Refunds for reservations that cannot be accommodated will be processed after August 15.
