DLPOA By-Laws and CC&Rs Rewrite Status

A group of residents have volunteered to revise the DLPOA By-Laws and Protective Restrictions, Conditions, Covenants and Reservations (CC&Rs). The rewrite committee decided to begin revising the By-Laws first.

The By-Laws provide rules and regulations that define how the business of our Association is conducted including how homeowners can become members of the DLPOA, how we elect Board Members and run our meetings as well as how our Committees function. The CC&Rs established the General Plan for protection, maintenance, improvement and development of the real property known as Dapplegray Lane. These documents were revised in August 1948 and in 1961. As a point of history, the City of Rolling Hills Estates



wasn't incorporated until 1957. Needless to say, things have changed.

The committee has had several meetings and has created a fairly mature draft which we are asking that the DLPOA property owners review and provide comment on if desired. Chuck Berman will have

posted the draft on the DLPOA Website at <u>www.Palosverdes.com/DLPOA</u> by the time you are reading this article. For those people interested in reading/commenting, but who do not have internet access, just call me at 310-325-9315 and I will drop off a copy to you.

The committee has formatted the draft in plain English as opposed to the original legalese. I hope that this format will assist in your review and understanding of the draft. I am asking that you complete your review by Sunday March 27 because the next committee meeting is March 29. The average high temperature for February 2011 was 66.6 degrees with a high temperature of 83.5 on the 12th.

The average low temperature was 42.6 with a low temperature of 34.8 on the 28th.

Starting around the middle of the month the February rainfall was 2.36 inches. Total for the rainfall year July 1 to June 30 is 16.10 inches.

Average rainfall for the years 2002 to and including February 2011 is 13.39 inches.

The highest February rainfall was 8.89 inches in 2005, the lowest was 0.37 inches in 2002.
