#### CONGRATULATIONS! WE DID IT!

Knowing was Everything! YOUR involvement in BARSEA/ TRTA brought financial relief to so many retirees this passed legislative session. Why? Because your awareness created a barrage of emails and phone calls to our legislators when they were undecided about giving us a 3% increase in our annuity. It had been over 12 years (2001) since we'd had a cost of living adjustment. If you don't

fit into the criteria this time around, you will next time.

So, with that, we CONGRATULATE all TRS retirees who will be receiving a 3% increase in their annuity October 1st. All TRS public school employees who retired on August 2004 or before, are eligible for this new Cost of Living Adjustment.(COLA.) The 83rd Legislative Session passed SB 1458 which relieved many retirees

burdened with the high cost of inflation. This bill also passed legislation that will make the TRS fund actuarially sound so that all retirees will be able to get a COLA in the near future. Maybe even in two years during the 84th Legislative session.
