Introduction

The NEC3 family of contracts has now become the contract family of choice for public sector projects in Northern Ireland.

The structure, terminology and concepts embodied in the NEC3 contracts are very different to those in the more familiar traditional standard form of contracts.

This one day course will cover the NEC3 Engineering and Construction **Short** Contract and Subcontract. This contract is ideal for low risk, low complexity contracts and single trade contracts or subcontracts.

- their principal objectives and the key features that deliver these objectives
- the important clauses including definitions, payment, quality and managing change and
- how to implement it effectively and efficiently.
