- Encourage visitors of all ages to learn about the zoo and conservatory, its exhibits/displays, the relationships between plants, animals, and humans through interactive learning
- Promote the interest of plants, animals and humans through interactive learning
- Practice effective interpretive techniques, present accurate information, encourage visitor participation, and assist with visitor needs
- Research educational resources for curriculum design and development of plant and animal fact sheets
- Educate Como visitors about plant and animal adaptations
- Assist or lead story time and interpretive talks
