Declaration of Brian Kim

I declare under penalty of perjury that the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge:

I was granted Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) on January 10, 2013. My deferred action is valid until January 9, 2015. I submit this declaration in support of my application for deferred action.

I am applying for an Advance Parole Document based on humanitarian reasons. My 89-year-old grandfather in South Korea is seriously ill. He suffered a stroke and has been diagnosed with diabetes. Recently, he was admitted to the hospital with influenza. Doctors and family do not expect him to return home.

I have not seen my grandfather in 11 years. He had a strong influence on me when I was a child in South Korea. This trip is likely the last opportunity that I'll have to visit him. It would be heartbreaking if I was not able to see him one last time.

I would like to visit South Korea on Sunday, June 15, 2014, and return to the United States on Saturday, June 28, 2014. My travel dates are flexible depending on the period allowed by my advance parole. Please help me spend time with my grandfather and reunite with my family on this short trip. Thank you.
