- Meet at the fall IMPACT Orientation Session at 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, November 11, 2015 and at least one of two PVAMU-sponsored IMPACT Events scheduled in Spring 2016 semester.
- Be committed to carry out agreed upon goals.
- Contact your mentor in a timely manner if you are unable to attend scheduled meetings.
- Expect to contact or meet with mentor 1-2 times per month in keeping with guidelines. I think we set minimum of twice a month
- Protégés should schedule meetings with mentors for no longer than 30 minutes, unless the mentor agrees to a longer meeting.
