

HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

HILLCREST APARTMENTS

Providing transitional apartments to homeless families, which includes a rigorous screening and education component. We sponsor two apartments. Assistance includes restocking the apartments when a family graduates. Time commitment is several hours of shopping a couple of times a year, plus contact with charity as needed. We stock their food pantry, provide Christmas gifts through Angel Tree, and provide coffee for the offices and meetings with clients.

ADDICTION SUPPORT

We meet one evening a month to pray, get material, (which is donated by parishioners), work on projects, learn from each other, and generally enjoy each other's company.
