## **General Information**

The Ashburn Volunteer Fire & Rescue Department (AVFRD) is a non-profit organization that provides Fire and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) to the local community. As part of our involvement with the community, we offer courses in *Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation* (CPR) to the public. The primary reason for this is that it is a very important skill. Minutes count. CPR is one of the first links in the *Chain of Survival* and all citizens should have some basic knowledge of how and when to use CPR.

CPR for Family and Friends. : (A class participation card is given at the end of the class, but is not considered a "credential.")

• This course targets all lay rescuers, such as school children, family members of patients at risk for sudden cardiac death, and other laypersons who want to learn rescue skills for loved ones. The course teaches rescuers skills in CPR and relief of foreign-body airway obstruction (FBAO/choking). It presents information about the AHA adult Chain of Survival and signs of heart attack, cardiac arrest, stroke and choking in adults. The text includes information about healthy heart living and action to reduce risk of cardiovascular disease in adults. The course also present information about the American Heart Association pediatric infant and child Chain of Survival, signs of choking in infants and children, prevention of sudden infant syndrome (SIDS) and prevention of the most common fatal injuries in infants and children. This class takes about 2 ½ - 3 hours

**Costs:** CPR Class Costs (AVFRD is a non-profit organization which may make this a tax-deductible expense. See your CPA for guidance.)

• The instruction we offer is free, as all of our instructors are volunteers. We charge only for the courseware and disposable materials. The costs proscribed below are for classes performed at the Ashburn Fire Rescue Station. We do not offer off-site classes

This course involves kneeling on the floor while performing rescue skills on a manikin. *Please check with your physician if you have any doubts about taking a class in CPR*.

The course is open to any individual **16 years of age or older** physically capable of performing the required skills.
