3. Water and Sewer Matters

- a. Sewage treatment plant and sanitary sewer collection system; costs and accounting; loading; permits; etc.
- b. Commitments, permits, new service requests, private water and sewer facilities, line extensions, reimbursement agreements, other agreements, construction contracts, payments to and from developers or owners, out-of-district service, annexations, easements, etc. and related matters, including: Willowbrook Church tract (Le-Vu medical project), Hammett tract, Braband tract and other tracts on SH249 between Hargrave and Schroeder Roads (including proposed Holiday Inns on Hammett tract); nearby tracts, including storage facility site on Schroeder Road; Dotson MOB office project on Dotson Road, office project on Hargrave at Dotson; infrastructure, easements, policies, regulations, hearing, agreements and new construction in Villas at Willowbrook (Stratford Way at Schroeder Road) and other properties.
- c. Wastewater treatment plant, monitoring, sampling and regulation of discharges, repairs, reports and related matters.
- d.
