

School Uniform Policy

The Brighton Secondary School Uniform Policy has been developed and confirmed by the school community through the Governing Council. We expect the co-operation of students, parents and staff.

Rationale

• In keeping with a long tradition of excellence and respect, all students are expected to proudly wear the Brighton Secondary School uniform. The uniform contains a range of options to suit all body shapes and ages. Wearing the school uniform assists in the provision of a safe school environment and provides cost effective, durable clothing.

Exemptions

- If medical reasons prevent the wearing of an item of the uniform, parents should provide the Home Group Teacher with a note specifying the time of requested exemption from the Uniform Policy. Appropriate clothes in school colours must still be worn.
- Requests for exemption will be referred to the relevant Principal Team member for approval, and an exemption sticker will be placed in the student's school planner.

In 2014 all year 8 students will purchase the new uniform. Students in all other year levels must purchase new items if replacing an item which no longer fits or has worn out. Old uniform items are no longer on sale.

Uniform will be available from the School Uniforms SA premises at 214 – 216 Main South Road, Morphett Vale (church on left hand side of South Road going south) (phone 8325 2255) from the beginning of January. Opening hours from this outlet are: Monday to Saturday, 9.00am – 5.00pm.

During the school year the shop is open Mondays, Tuesdays 8.00am – 11.00am and Thursdays 12.30pm – 4.00pm at the school. On-line sales will be available in the near future. Lay-by is available and Credit Card payments are accepted. Over the phone payment (phone 8325 2255) can be made and parcels collected from Brighton Secondary School or the Morphett Vale store.

Formal School Uniform

When representing the school e.g. debating competitions, SLC formal duties.

Girls

- Black leather lace-up school shoes
- Black or navy opaque tights (denier 50 +)
- Long hair is to be worn pulled back off the face with navy blue hair ties, "scrunchies" or ribbons
- White and green pinstripe shirt
- BSS tartan, mid-calf length skirt
- BSS tie
- BSS blazer

Boys

- Black leather lace-up school shoes
- Black socks
- Charcoal grey trousers
- White and green pinstripe shirt
- BSS tie
- BSS blazer

Sports Uniform

Students are required to wear the multi-purpose P.E./Sports uniform during practical P.E. lessons.

- BSS navy sports shorts
- BSS sports shirt
- BSS navy track pants (optional)
- BSS navy jacket (optional)

Special Interest Music and Special Interest Volleyball Program Students

There are specific uniform requirements for volleyball students and for music students. Both the volleyball students and special interest music students are encouraged to have a jacket with relevant logo and wording, and navy track pants, to be worn on trips and excursions.

Further Information about the Uniform Policy

Please note the following details which clarify the Uniform Policy.

- Students must change into suitable clothing and footwear for physical education lessons and wear school uniform at all other times.
- Students must wear closed school shoes for Home Economics, Design and Technical Studies, Science and Music.
- Uniforms for sports teams are available for loan and purchase and must be worn when representing the school.
- "Cargo-style" pants, jeans or other "fashion pants" are not acceptable for school wear.
- Jewellery and make-up should be discreet. No facial piercings or visible tattoos.
- On "non-uniform" days students should wear appropriate clothing and shoes that do not contravene the Work, Health, Safety requirements of the school.
- Special polo shirts, e.g. House Captains, are to be worn by participants only in the term of the event.
